Under the project two exemplary schools in the Asbah Al Subh School in Tripoli and Al Huryaa in El Baida were established. On both schools DCVI installed a complete language lab, a smart class room and demonstration room for all equipment for sports, music and arts & craft, all including necessary furniture, tools and ICT equipment.

Main feature of the project was to integrate ICT based learning at secondary school level. This was done through the smart classroom concept in which practical science experiments are combined with virtual science experiments, allowing the students to learn through trial and error in a safe environment.
