<p>The overall objective of the of the AfDB TVET for Relevant Skills Development Phase II Project in line with the Kenya TVET Act, 2013 is to increase access and equity, improve quality and relevance of TVET. The specific objective of the phase II project is to equip youth, at least 50% of them women, with relevant TVET skills for the immediate and emerging labour market needs. The expected project outcome is increased skilled and employable youths. The objectives are in line with the objectives of other plans of the GoK, the Vision 2030, the Second Medium term Plan (MTP) 2013-2017 and the National Education Sector Plan (NESP) 2014 to 2018.</p> <p>The assignment “Consulting services for developing TVETA accreditation procedures and manuals, and conduct training of TVETA staff, monitors and evaluators” is embedded in a larger range of measures and interventions to improve relevance, quality, equity and access to TVET in Kenya.</p> <p>The challenge that will need to be overcome by the specific consultancy assignment is that the quality of training provided at different institutes.
