Project description

Focusing on the most migration prone regions of Ethiopia, SINCE intends to contribute to the reduction of irregular migration by improving living conditions of the most vulnerable population. Specifically, the Programme aims at creating wage employment opportunities for potential migrants and returnees, especially women and youths, by strengthening the capacities of local Technical Vocational Education and Training, service providers and promoting Public Private Partnerships (PPPs) in strategic economic clusters.

The purpose of this contract is the production of four case studies, one for each of the four strategic topics; (i) the creation of Public Private Partnerships (PPPs) among TVET institution, PES and private enterprises, (ii) the strengthening of Public Employment Services (PES), (iii) the promotion of Decent Work within the private sectors, and (iv) the promotion of Apprenticeship schemes.

The aim of these case studies is twofold:

- the case studies should systematize what was achieved by the different SINCE grant beneficiaries, with a particular focus on the lessons learnt;
- the case studies reports should draw recommendations on policy development and future interventions.

In order to ensure that maximum knowledge is gained, it is important that the case studies concentrate on the SINCE lessons learnt so that they could act as a tool for capitalizing on these, thus enabling good practice to be disseminated.



Expected results are:

Result 1: Analysis of SINCE financed projects and systematization of experiences and lessons learnt, the case studies should focus on the strategic topics, and on the lessons learnt in different aspects such as (i) policy framework, (ii) project environment, (iii) design, (iv) impact, and (v) sustainability and replication.

Result 2: Recommendations for policy makers and the Community of Practice concerning (i) policy strengthening, (ii) design of new initiatives replicating the promotion of wage employment, and (iii) partnerships between complementary actors.
