Cadena IDP is responsible for overall project management, and the provision of technical assistance and training.</p> <p>The training for academic staff on ICT skills development includes advanced training on using E-learning Platform (Moodle) for interactive teaching, learning and assessment (Advanced Features), these include online content and classroom management systems, Training on Smart Learning Technologies, Virtual and Smart Laboratory technologies. Training on using Internet of Things (IoT), Artificial Intelligence, and Machine Learning for smart teaching and learning. Training on simulation and virtual reality technologies for smart teaching. Learning. Training on JavaScript for Virtual Labs Development and Management Training on Internet Security, Intranet, Cloud Computing and VPN Technologies.</p> <p>Besides that, there is a training for IT technicians covering Training on Internet Security, Intranet, Cloud Computing, VPN and internet last mile technologies, Training on Maintenance and Management of Smart Classrooms (these include interactive touch screens, TVs and Whiteboards, and other classroom hardware and software).
